

Interview with Running Man Part 1 - Transcript

Insider51: Welcome to They Do No Come In Peace

Tonight, we've got a very important episode for you. I've got a guy on the phone whose story confirms many of the suspicions I've had for years. He calls himself Running Man, and he's a former guard at a secret underground military installation. He's agreed to tell us about some of the horrible things that went on there. For starters, he says that some of the research they're doing at this base is conducted on unwilling subjects. And folks, that's just the beginning.

A mutual contact introduced me to Running Man about a month ago, and the information he's given me so far is some of the scariest stuff I've heard in a long time. But as I've always said, the truth—the real truth—about what's going on with our government is so frightening you can't help but want to disbelieve. But you have to keep an open mind here because some of the stuff Running Man is going to tell us jives with a lot of the things I've seen and heard in the fifteen years I've been trying to tear the lid off this whole damn thing.

Before we get started, I need to mention one thing. Running Man has picked up some kind of handheld device to disguise his voice from...well, from the government for one. But, honestly, they might be the least of this guy's worries.

INSIDER51: Running Man, so you worked at some kind of a top-secret military base. Can you tell us about it? Where's it located?

RUNNING MAN: Well, I can tell you a lot. I can't tell you everything, cuz I was only there for a few weeks before I...you, know, before I went...you know, before. But I saw a lot.

It's Army, obviously. Cuz, you know, I was Army. But there're civies there, too. Scientists, mostly. The whole place is all scientific. I mean, it's not high tech. I think it's old. But it's all science stuff done there. Bio, uh, gene-genetic -

INSIDER51: Genetic Research?

RUNNING MAN: Yeah, Genetic Research. Other stuff, too.

INSIDER51: What else are they working on?

RUNNING MAN: Uh...I already told you.

INSIDER51: I know, but my listeners need to hear this, too.

RUNNING MAN: There's a deal with the government. Some of the guys said that's where we got stuff like stealth fighters and cell phones, but I never saw that stuff. Some also said the President doesn't even know about it.

INSIDER51: The President of the United States?

RUNNING MAN: Yeah, the President. It's not supposed to exist.

RUNNING MAN: Oh, yeah. New Mexico. In the north part, under some mountain...a uh, mesa. It's called Subterra Bravo.

INSIDER51: Tell the listeners what you mean by volunteers.

RUNNING MAN: They're not really volunteers, that's what they wanted us to call them. They're people, you know, civilians. They get picked up -

INSIDER51: By who?

RUNNING MAN: I already told you. By the collection teams. You know, guys like me.

INSIDER51: Just to be clear, you're saying that U.S. soldiers are abducting tax-paying citizens of the United States and taking them to this base?

RUNNING MAN: Yeah. But, nobody likes it. We hafta.

INSIDER51: Why?

RUNNING MAN: Cuz that's our job. We're grunts. They tell us to jump, we jump.

INSIDER51: No. Why are the free people of this country being abducted by their own government?

RUNNING MAN: Oh. Research. They're guinea pigs for the experiments.

INSIDER51: The government is experimenting on civilians?

RUNNING MAN: Well...not really the government. I think they're just helping.

INSIDER51: Then who is doing the experiments on these poor people?

RUNNING MAN: ...The uh...the aliens.

INSIDER51: I've already heard this, but I want you to say it again for everyone listening. You're saying aliens—extraterrestrials from another planet—are working with our government and performing experiments on abducted U.S. citizens?

RUNNING MAN: ...

INSIDER51: Hello? Running Man? Tell everyone about the aliens! This is huge!
